Lynne Randall loved the people of Bolivia. She was a member of the second mission trip led by Bonnie Jones in 1989. After that, over the next decade she organized and led six work-team trips for members from her home church, Christ United Methodist Church in Plano, Texas. Work teams led by Lynne improved health clinics and schools in rural Bolivia and brought smiles and love to work team members and Bolivians that had the pleasure of meeting and working with her. She cared deeply for the Bolivian women and children and understood the importance of Andean Rural Health Care bringing the census-based, impact-oriented health model to their villages.

Lynne was dedicated to educating others about the gifts, spirit, and circumstances of her beloved Aymaran friends. She had a true passion for the people and mission of ARHC. It was important to her to support ARHC in any possible way. Lynne was a member of the Board of Directors of Andean Rural Health Care from 1992 to 2001 and served as Chair from 1998-2001. Lynne was an active fund raiser and a liaison for ARHC with her church. She also hosted visiting staff when they were in Texas. She became close friends with many other supporters of ARHC and had a deep love and appreciation for John Wyon as a friend and as someone who provided enormous strength to the work.
